The presentation should deal with geographic information science and technology and, preferably, issues in New Mexico.

Abstract Guidelines

Abstracts are limited to 300 words and must include a brief description of the problem statement, objectives, methods, results, and conclusions. Please be sure to also include the following in your abstract: authors and their affiliations, title, and three to five keywords. **The deadline to submit an abstract is 18 March 2017.** We encourage you to submit early to ensure a placement in the program. Information about Paper and Poster Presentations

Each paper, including the presentation and a discussion, is allotted 20 minutes. A computer and projector will be provided to facilitate the presentation. Posters should fit on a 4' × 8' poster board. **There will be a poster competition for students (cash prizes!).**
